

# SITO MORESCO

(SEE-toh moh-RES-koh)

The name derives from Moresco, the previous owner of the parcel in Pajorè vineyard which was purchased in 1979.



<b>Winery</b>	GAJA, Barbaresco, Piedmont.
<b>Denomination</b>	Langhe D.O.P.
<b>Varieties</b>	Nebbiolo, Barbera, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon.
<b>Vineyards</b>	Mainly Pajorè in Treiso and in Serralunga. Exposure: eastern and western exposure. Soil: predominantly limestone.
<b>Winemaking method</b>	Fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks and oak casks.
<b>Characteristics</b>	Sito Moresco combines the complexity and longevity of Nebbiolo with the body of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The wine has a refined bouquet of small red fruits. In the mouth it is elegant, fruity and harmonious. Fresh end with smooth tannins making the wine suitable for immediate but also late drinking.
